Ref: Possible violation of General Orders

Sgt. Laney,

As you may know, I have been conducting a series of public record inspections as authorized by FSS 119.07 in order to verify or dispute information which has been provided to me. I have utilized this format in order to avoid filing a formal complaint with your agency prior to having all of the facts. As of this date I have been able to verify by documentation that the allegations appear to be factual. And as such I am affording you this opportunity to tell your side of the story or correct any information which I am in possession of prior to proceeding forward.

I am requesting that you admit, deny or explain the following:

1. You were hired by the SCSO after having previously being fired by Sheriff Polk who later changed the reason for your termination as a result of your not being truthful during an investigation.
2. You were later hired by the Oviedo Police Department as a dispatcher then as a Police Officer for the Oviedo Police Department.
3. As a result of your committing a crime and because you had embarrassed the Department, while employed by the Oviedo Police Department, you advised Chief Peterson and Lt. Smeltzer that you wanted to resign as a Police Officer.
4. That on May 18, 1991 you married Joy Lynn Williams.
5. That the mother of Joy Lynn Williams is Carolyn C. Williams.
6. That you had knowledge prior to being rehired by the Seminole County Sheriff's Office, on January 12, 1993, as a Deputy, that Carolyn C. Williams had served as a member of the Seminole County Grand Jury, Spring Term 1992.
7. That you had knowledge that Carolyn C. Williams while at the scene of a suicide on May 18, 1992 met Sheriff Donald F. Eslinger.
