Dear Capt. Akins,


The Office of the State Attorney has reviewed the investigative findings concerning allegations made against the Seminole Police Athletics' League, the Seminole County Sheriff's Office, Sgt. Dwayne Johnson, and Steve Rostroff. Be advised there is no reasonable likelihood of a successful prosecution of either the organizations or the individuals based on the information you provided.

At the heart of every prosecution is what is commonly referred to as criminal intent. We whole heartily agree with your assessment that there is no evidence of criminal intent on the part of the organizations or the individuals. No one benefitted from the accounting oversight.

Thank you for the thorough and concise investigative effort. For the reasons mentioned above we will not institute any criminal proceeding against the Seminole Police Athletics' League, the Seminole County Sheriff's Office, Sgt.
