I am attempting to finish a story on the above identified event involving Deputy Sheriff Victoria Futch and Deputy Bailey. In order to publish the facts I require your assistance to explain the actions of Deputy Futch. I have attached an amended draft for my story and if any facts concerning your deputy are in error I would like your assistance to make any corrections if necessary.

I am extending this courtesy to your department in a spirit of fairness with the goal to provide only factual information to my readers and specifically to the tax payers of Seminole County Florida. As such I require clarification as to details concerning this event.

1. Was Deputy Futch dispatched to the location?
2. If Deputy Futch was dispatched who was the complainant and what was the nature of the complaint?
3. Did the property owner of the subject property give SCSO and or its Deputy Sheriff's prior permission to enter the roped off property which was marked by a POSTED sign at the point of entry / exit?
4. If this prior permission was obtained, is there a written document authorizing this entry?
5. If such a public record is in the possession of the SCSO please provide a copy of this public record.
6. If no such public record is in the possession of the SCSO , please advise of this fact in writing.
7. If any information is available to explain why the entry was made into the property please provide that information.

As I am at a deadline on this story , time is of the essence.

Your attention to this matter is greatly appreciated. If your office does not want to comment on this event could you extend to me the professional courtesy to advise me that you will not comment as soon as possible and then I can proceed forward.

Mrs. Peters,

Thank you for your immediate reply and providing the public record.

I have attached a draft of an article which I am researching concerning the event. As you can tell there is some discrepancy in the nature of how it was that Deputy Sheriff Victoria Futch ended up driving into the hole.

When I spoke with Deputy Futch yesterday on the scene I understood her to say that there was a male walking on the property and if I understand the Event Report which you forwarded to me Deputy Futch was either dispatched to the scene or else she self initiated the call. And that a Green SUV with at least two had just" went on unposted property". Dispatched, enroute and arrived times all at 15:31:52. And then Deputy Bailey arrived 36 seconds later and called for a tow truck 2 in. 55 seconds later.

If I am in error , concerning how my story is written concerning the fact that a male was walking on the property please advise. It is very important that the facts are presented and that any misunderstanding is corrected prior to publishing this story. I realize that this is not really a request that you normally would address but as I promised I would not communicate with any other SCSO employee since the BLOCK was lifted.

The event report fails to mention what ever happened to the SUV or who the two persons were.

If you would rather that I obtain my information from another source please advise and I will address my concerns to the proper person. Please feel free to forward this draft to Deputy Futch.
