

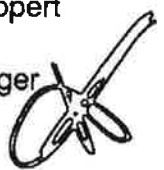

SUBJECT: Disciplinary Action



Effective this date, you are suspended without pay for ten (10) working days. Additionally, you are to reimburse the Seminole County Sheriff's Office a total of \$690.00 for monies expended on travel and course tuition for the seminar you did not attend.

Administrative Investigation PC-95-0031 has resulted in your being found in violation of General Order #29, subsection I-B-3, "**Failure of an employee to report to work, or make timely notification to their immediate supervisor to obtain approval for leave.**" This finding was upheld upon review by the Disciplinary Review Board on October 27, 1995.

Your failure to attend the *Officer Survival Instructor's Course* offered by the Metropolitan Police Institute in Miami, without prior approval after expenditure for the course, was inexcusable. Had your absence been from "on duty" law enforcement activities rather than a scheduled seminar, the consequences would have been more severe.

Pursuant to applicable Civil Service Laws, you may appeal this decision to the Sheriff's Office Civil Service Board. If you desire an appeal hearing, you must file a written notice of appeal with Steven Harriett, Chairman, Seminole County Sheriff's Office Civil Service Board, 1345-28th Street, Sanford, Florida 32773-9399 within ten (10) days of this date. If you submit a written notice of appeal, an appeal hearing will be scheduled within thirty (30) days.
